- To clean cabinet doors and exteriors properly, simply use a damp washcloth with perhaps a small amount of mild dish soap.
- DO NOT use any strong or abrasive cleaners such as Windex or Comet, as you may damage the finish or remove the protective UV coating, which guards against color fade.
- **In the event of a major grease splatter, in which mild dish soap does not lift the stain, please contact the Office for advice. DO NOT USE ANY PRODUCT NOT RECOMMENDED. IF ANY DAMAGE IS CAUSED, THE MEMBER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REPLACEMENT COST.**
- Although day to day cooking will not be a problem, it is recommended to pull the oven ahead 6 to 8 inches before starting self-clean mode.
- Please avoid leaving boiling or steaming items, such as a tea-kettle directly underneath upper cabinets. Pull ahead to countertop edge as much as possible in order to avoid moisture damage.
